



Centennial School District Return to Learn Two Options for Families Fall 2020



Comprehensive Distance Learning (CDL)

Full-Year Online (CVA) Centennial Virtual Academy

Daily teacher-directed learning through live online instruction, recorded instruction, and online activities
Students will remain in this format until Multnomah County is in Phase 2 for reopening
Curriculum- Centennial School District district-adopted curriculum and additional resources will be used to provide a full educational experience
Students will be taught by teachers from their neighborhood school
Students will be grouped in virtual classrooms with peers from their neighborhood school
This option allows the Centennial School District to transition to a Hybrid model (partial in-person learning) when state and county safety requirements are met, and eventually to full-time daily regular in-person learning in school.

Self-paced independent instruction with weekly teacher check-in and support from an adult family member at home
Students in this format will remain online for the entire 2020-21 school year
Curriculum-Engenuity and Odysseyware fully online curriculum will be used and some electives will be available
Students will have access to Centennial teachers for support, but not necessarily from their neighborhood school
Students will have limited interactions with other students in the yearlong online program from all over the district
This option requires a yearlong commitment and does not allow students to transition to Comprehensive Distance Learning or a Hybrid model.
