Welcome

McKay (FLO Analytics) welcomed the committee and reminded folks that this meeting would be recorded for committee members to review if unable to attend.

Meeting Goal

Kent (FLO Analytics) reviewed the evening's agenda, committee charge and guiding principles. He shared that the goal for this meeting was for the committee to come to consensus on a boundary scenario to bring forward for community input at the open house scheduled for Tuesday evening, November 16th at Centennial Middle School from 6:00 – 8:00 PM.

Workgroup Task

Two committee scenarios (Scenario 7 and Scenario 9) were reviewed with the committee to show the similarities of these two maps as well as the resulting balance of student enrollment at each district school both now and in the future. The two existing workgroups were then requested to study these two scenarios, along with the other ten scenarios the committee had developed in previous workshops to determine which scenario they would like to share with the community at the open house.

The committee was reminded that the scenario they eventually determine to bring forward will only be around 50%-60% complete, and that after community input is received on this scenario, the committee will then need to continue making revisions (in subsequent committee workshops) to develop a refined scenario that is around 85%-90% complete (for presentation at the second community open house in January).

Committee Consensus Scenario

Each workgroup shared their respective discussions with the entire committee on which scenario should be shared with the community. Scenario 9 was brought forward for a vote, and the parent committee members all voted in favor of this scenario becoming Committee Consensus Scenario #1.

Next Steps

Committee Consensus Scenario #1 map and summary statistics will be presented at an in-person open house at Centennial Middle School next Tuesday, November 16th from 6:00 – 8:00 PM. The district will also provide a video with boundary committee information along with this consensus scenario map and summary statistics. Parent and community input will be requested electronically on a google survey that will be housed on the district's boundary review landing page.

Input received from the electronic survey will be organized for the committee members to review prior to the next boundary review committee (BRC) meeting on Tuesday, November 30th. As with previous committee workshop meetings, BRC members will continue to develop and refine boundary scenarios in their workgroups, incorporating this parent and community input within their discussions and scenario modeling.
